**RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICT COUNCIL
(TEMPORARY DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC)
HIGH STREET
PARISH OF OAKHAM AND VARIOUS PARISHES ORDER 2018**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 16A (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) High Street Parish of Oakham and Various Parishes Order 2018, as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because a Cycle Race event, is proposed to be held on or near the road.

There will be a Rolling Road Closure along the course, to facilitate the passage of an International Cycle Road Race, and the temporary removal of speed (30mph) restrictions at all points on the course, and enforcement of No Parking restrictions on High Street and Market Place Oakham and on Normanton Road, Edith Weston.

The effect of the order will be that during the date and times specified below:

1.

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as High Street; from Mill Street to Melton Road, Market Street and Market Place from their junctions with the High Street. The duration of the Closures shall be as follows: 08:00 - 16:00 hours on Sunday 22nd April 2018. The Closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

2.

a). Unless otherwise instructed by a Police Officer, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to stand on or proceed along the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to the Order reproduced below, while the race participants and race support vehicles are negotiating the route on the said lengths of roads.

b). Unless otherwise instructed by a Police Officer, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to the Order reproduced below, including from any entrances/exits to or from premises situated thereon, whilst the cyclists are negotiating the route on the said lengths of roads.

The effect of the Order will be that during the date and times specified below, all vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting along the length of road known as High Street, Market Street and Market Place. The duration of Parking Restrictions shall be as follows:- 00:01 hours until 16:00 hours on 22nd April 2018.

Whilst the Closure is in force, the speed restrictions affecting the roads to be closed, as specified in the Order, will be suspended to allow the race participants and the accompanying entourage only, to legally proceed at speeds in excess of the relevant restriction.

The Order shall come into force at 00:01 hours on Sunday 22nd April 2018 for a period of 24 hours and may be cited as the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Closure of Various Roads) Towns of Oakham and Various Parishes Order 2018.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises whilst the event is in progress.

The closure and the Race Route are shown on the attached plan (also available to view at the Council Office) and/or as shown on roadworks.org
