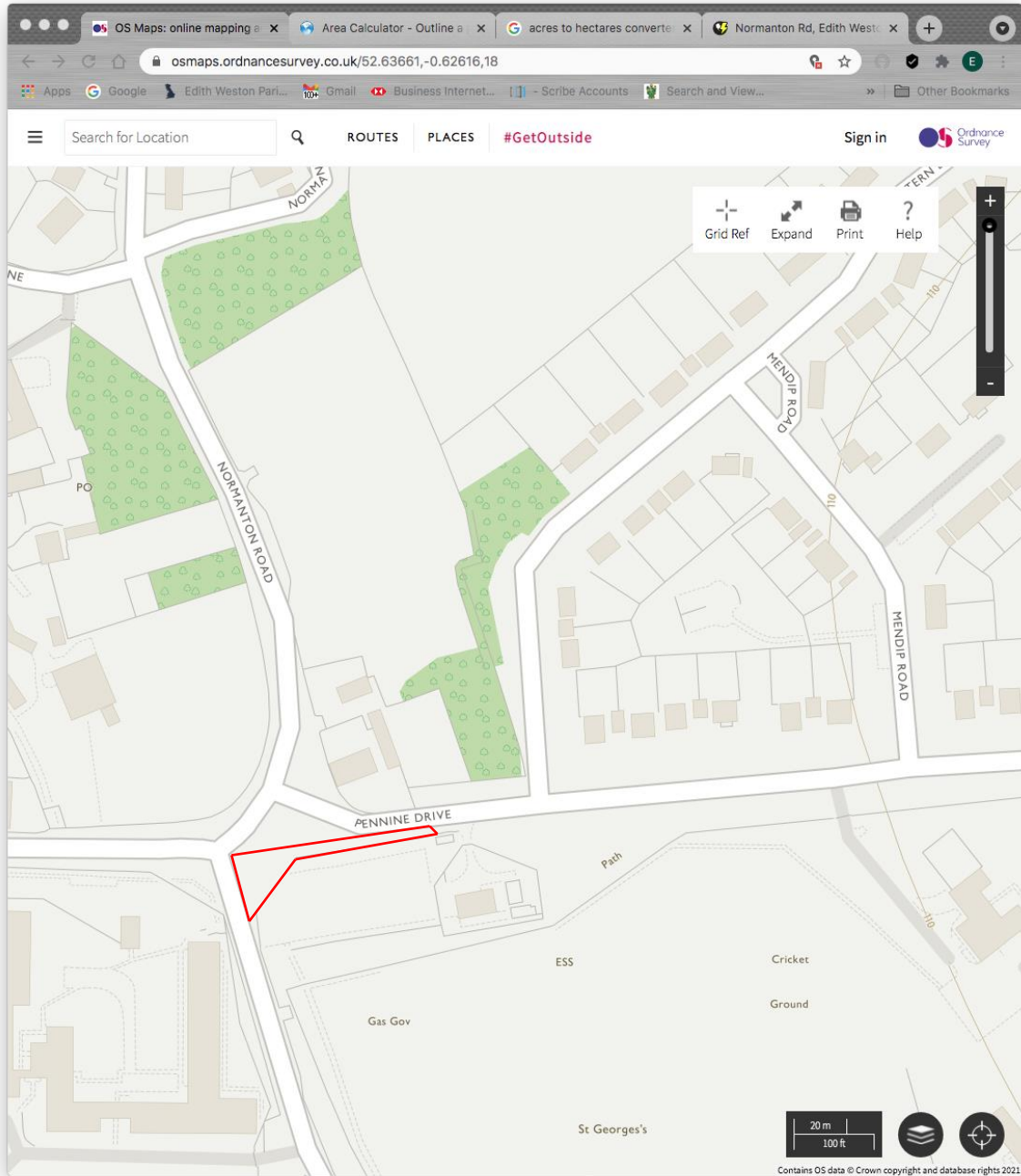


# Local Green Space Assessment Report

## Special Community Value

The area of land forms a vital link to the village history and the important part that RAF North Luffenham has played in the development of the village. The stones are memorial to the pilots that

flew from RAF North Luffenham during WW2. This forms a focal point at the intersection of the three main routes into/out of the village. It forms both a social and historical point of interest.
