An important update on the Future Rutland Conversation

Dear Resident,

I'm writing to you with an important update about the Future Rutland Conversation.

I hope you'll remember my previous letter in April, when I explained that we were starting a conversation with local people to understand what you value most about life in Rutland. By having this conversation and hearing from you on a wide range of important issues, we want to develop a new Shared Vision for the future of our County – a set of long-term goals based on the things you said are most important to you.

After hearing from more than 2,000 people who shared their views on topics like the environment, transport, quality of life and healthcare, a Draft Future Rutland Vision has been published, describing the kind of place people say they want to live. Between now and 28 November 2021, anyone with a connection to Rutland is being asked to read the Draft Future Rutland Vision and share what they think.

So, what's the point to all this? Well, with all the uncertainty and change that we've experienced over the past two years, it's vital that our County has a clear set of long-term goals for the future – goals that have been shaped by you and which help organisations and communities to make the right changes.

Having asked lots of questions and listened carefully to everything you said, we now want your views on the Draft Future Rutland Vision. It doesn't matter if you haven't taken part in the Future Rutland Conversation before. We still want to hear from you. We want to know if the Rutland of the future that's described in the Vision is a place you want to live.
